- Be attentive to children's needs.

Qualifications:

- Basic understanding of children's development (i.e. age appropriate activities, child safety)
- Sensitivity to the needs of victims of domestic violence and their children, and the unique obstacles they face.
- Understanding of and experience working with people from diverse backgrounds.
- Ability to maintain complete confidentiality.
- Dependable and punctual.
- Must be at least 18 years old.
- Must agree to a criminal background check.

The Position is 1 evening per week: Wednesdays for 2 hours with possibility of additional monthly 2-3 hour groups (dates/times TBD).
